Bartlesville Kiwanis Club Senior of the Year Award 2024

History:

The Kiwanis Senior of the Year Award involves an application process for students at the five Washington County High Schools.

The Award will include a number of elements. Each student will receive a personalized Award Plaque that will be presented at the time each High School presents awards to its seniors at a special school assembly.

In addition, a \$1000 cash award will also be presented to each of the winning students at a Local Kiwanis Club event on **a date to be announced**. The winning student's parents and representatives from each school will also be invited as our guests to this event.

Bartlesville High School is a participant in our Award program because it is located in our own hometown. The City of Dewey and Dewey High School have close ties with Bartlesville and the School also is the site of our own Club's sponsored Key Club. Once again, this year we are happy to announce that we are including all Washington county schools which includes Caney Valley, Copan, and Wesleyan.

The Senior of the Year Award is not based on academics, but on leadership qualities. A primary goal is to seek out, recognize and develop leadership potential among high school seniors, and to encourage and prepare the next generation of civic and corporate leadership for America's future. Another goal is to educate people in the schools and communities about our local Bartlesville Kiwanis Club.

The winners will be selected by two separate panels of judges from the Bartlesville Kiwanis Club. The first panel of judges will first narrow down each school's applicants to a "short list" of its top three candidates. A second panel of judges will then select a winner at each school from its list of top three candidates. This two-phased judging process will help us insure the most fair and objective selection of winners among the applicants.
